Celebrating A Cyclone

Almost 100 years ago, on June 30, 1912 the Regina Cyclone blew its way through downtown Regina. About 50 buildings were damaged or destroyed, including Knox Presbyterian Church on the corner of 12th Avenue and Lorne Street.



Some of the glass from the magnificent stained glass windows in that church is included in the stained glass installation at the back of the sanctuary at Wesley United Church.

Between now and June 30, there will be several events to celebrate the 100th anniversary of that cyclone.

One of these will take place starting at **12:00 noon, February 20th at a Regina and District Oldtimers Soup and Sandwich lunch at Lakeview United Church, 3200 McCallum Ave. Lunch is \$5, and all are welcome.**

Trev Quinn will be there to tell the story of how that glass ended up here at Wesley. There will also be a video presentation with photos and memories from the time of the cyclone.

Following lunch (at 2:30 pm) guests will be invited to stop at Wesley to view the actual stained glass installation.
